1. History and Basic Information of Institute

The institute campus is well developed with latest facilities & modern amenities. The informal and harmonious campus life offers opportunities for the students to pursue their studies, do their work as well as various extra- curricular activities. The campus, situated at Gorakhpur-Lucknow bypass, is conveniently connected to all destinations in Gorakhpur City.

KIPM-College of Engineering have been established under the aegis of Ashutosh Shiksha Evam Sewa Sansthan in the benevolent guidance and leadership of Er. R. D. Singh (President of the Society), to provide quality education to the students of Engineering. The Promoters are driven by an objective that our students need to be highly accomplished, enterprising and committed citizens so that they deliver the best values. In order to achieve such an objective, we follow well-designed and professionally formulated way of doing things supported by proficient and experienced teachers, a set of adequate infrastructure, and good ambience. The Institute is ISO 9001:2008 QMS Certified for all of its courses.

1.1 Central Library

KIPM is endowed with a Central Library that is connected with 07 departmental libraries. It has about 1.5 lac books on Engineering, Sciences, Humanities, Management and Pharmacy with more than 10000 titles. The library has subscribed more than 205 Periodicals (National & International). The library also owns the subscription of e-journals i.e., IEEE/IEE, Science Direct-Engg. & EBSCO. The library is fully air conditioned and has a separate multimedia section with internet connectivity for accessing e-journals & other sites of user's interest. It is fully automated with Library Management System Software under ERP. The library, at KIPM, is an exclusive member of DELNET, IETE, IEI, CSI, ISTE, AIMA, CII and others. The library has a separate facility of Book-Bank with more than 1 lac books. The book bank issues the course books to the students for the entire semester. The institute is a proud member of NDL (National Digital Library), an initiative taken by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD). The database of NDL is easily accessible to the faculty, staff and students.

1.2 Seminar Hall

KIPM College of Engineering & Technology envisions a holistic development of its students' personality through various curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities round the year. For the same, the campus houses a high-tech auditorium with the capacity of accommodating around six hundred spectators. Along with it, the institute encompasses three more conference halls viz., A-Block Conference Hall, MBA Conference Hall and KSOP Conference Hall with the capacity of one hundred each.

1.3 Cafeteria

A fully air-conditioned double floored Cafeteria with comfortable, ergonomic furniture with the capacity for around two hundred and fifty foodies is an essential part of KIPM. Hygienic and lip-smacking vegetarian Indian, (Both north and south Indian), Chinese and continental food is available at a nominal price for the students.

1.4 Guest House

There are three VIP fully furnished Guest Houses and few visitors' or parents' waiting rooms in the campus. Out station parents can avail the facility of using these rooms after confirmation of their availability. These guest rooms can always be booked through respective hostel wardens.

8. Information Regarding Affiliating University

8.1 About AKTU

8.1.1 Establishment

Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Technical University (AKTU)(formerly UPTU) was established by the Government of Uttar Pradesh, vide Act Amendment No. 1156(2) LXXIX-V-1-15-1(Ka), 24-2015 dated Sept 9, 2015 Uttar Pradesh Adhiniyam Sankhya 23 of 2000. Under the University Act, 'Technical Education' includes programmes of education, research and training in Engineering, Technology, Architecture, Town Planning, Pharmacy, Applied Arts & Crafts and such other programmes and areas that the central Government may in consultation with All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) by notification in Gazette declare.

8.1.2 Affiliation

The University is affiliating in nature and its jurisdiction spans the entire state of U.P. in affiliating B.Tech., M.B.A., M.C.A., B.Arch., B. Pharma., B.H.M.C.T., M.Tech. and Ph.D. programmes in 764 colleges/institutions imparting graduate, postgraduate and doctoral level training in all government and private institutions located all over U.P. in engineering, technology, architecture, pharmacy, hotel management and catering technology as well as M.B.A. and M.C.A. programmes.

8.1.3 Grandiosity

U.P. being the largest state of India with an area of around two lacs forty thousand square kilometers and population of more than 165 million people makes AKTU as one of the largest technical universities not only in India but perhaps in Asia. Because of its gigantic size and number of colleges affiliated to it and geographic dispersion, it has been sub-divided into five zones with 150-160 colleges in each zone for the ease of management and facilitating inter-zonal comparison and possible internal competition to enhance quality of teaching-learning processes.

AKTU envisions to facilitate and nurture the quality of technical education and research in its own premises as well as all affiliating institutions. The total number of affiliated colleges was 49 in the year 2000 which has now gone up to 756 and the University is still growing. The University Conducts State level Entrance Examination U.P.S.E.E. for admission to various programs in institutions affiliated to AKTU and some Universities of U.P.. The University conducts central examinations in each semester for all the affiliated colleges and institutions and declares results quickly using technology-enabled systems. At present around 4,00,000 students are enrolled in its various programmes.

8.1.4 Reconstituted

AKTU was reconstituted as "Gautam Buddha Technical University, Lucknow" and "Mahamaya Technical University, Noida" on 1st May 2010 through amendment of U.P. Govt. vide act no. 05 of 2010, Subsequently U.P. Government again combined the Gautam Buddha Technical University and Mahamaya Technical University with effect from 1st Nov. 2013 vide amendment act 21st of 2013 and reconstituted A.K.T.U. Lucknow.

8.1.5 AKTU

AKTU is currently located at Sec-11, Jankipuram, Vistar Yojna, 226031 in the Capital of U.P. at Lucknow but is in the process of having its own Headquarter building in its vicinity. AKTU also has a NOIDA Centre to facilitate closer academic and industrial interaction around that zone where a prominent cluster of private affiliated colleges exists.

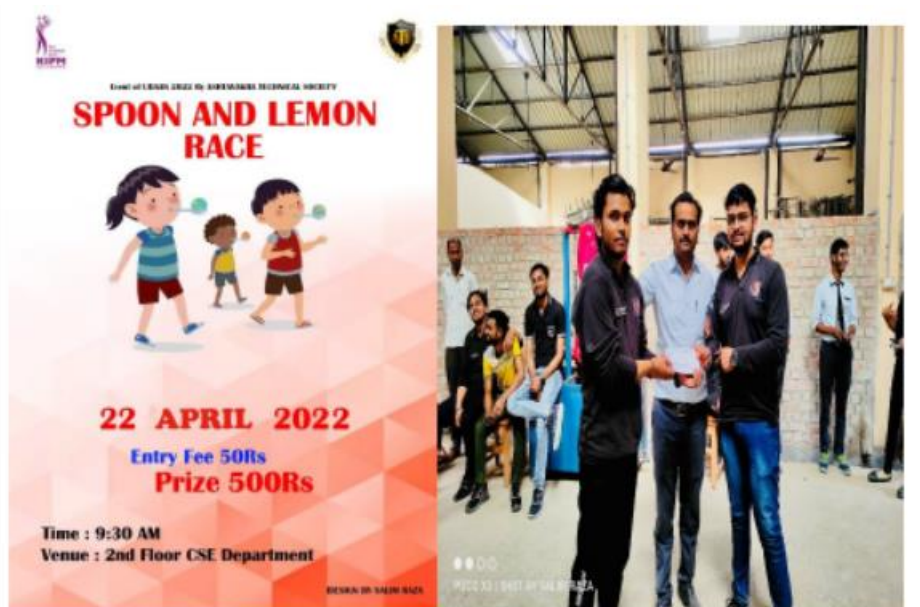

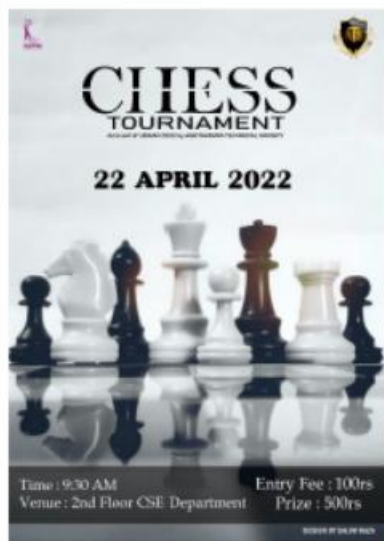

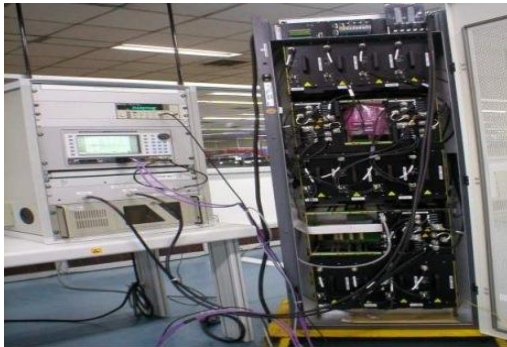

Students of EED 3rd year, KIPM-CET visited Barahuwa substation on 20th Nov 2021 with faculties Er. S.R. Somanshu and Er. Nitish Tiwari. As scheduled bus departed from KIPM-CET at 10:00 AM and reached Barahuwa substation on 20th Nov 2021 at 10:20 AM for industrial visit. After tea, a power point presentation and introduction class were held. The detail of introductory class is as follows: -

An important function performed by a substation is switching, which is the connecting and disconnecting of transmission lines or other components to and from the system. Switching events may be "planned" or "unplanned". A transmission line or other component may need to be de-energized for maintenance or for new construction, for example, adding or removing a transmission line or a transformer. To maintain reliability of supply, no company ever brings down its whole system for maintenance. All work to be performed, from routine testing to adding entirely new substations, must

be done while keeping the whole system running Perhaps more important, a fault may develop in a transmission line or any other component.

Some examples of this:

A line is hit by lightning and a tower is blown down by high wind. The function of the switching station is to isolate the faulted portion of the system in the shortest possible time. De-energizing faulted equipment protects it from further damage, and isolating the fit keeps the rest of the electrical grid operating with stability.



220KV Sub-station:

220KV Sub-Station forms an important link between Transmission network and Distribution network. It has a vital influence of reliability of service. Apart from ensuring efficient transmission and Distribution of power, the sub-station configuration should be such that it enables easy maintenance of equipment and minimum interruptions in power supply. Sub-Station is constructed near as possible to the load center.

There the students learned that the 220 KV Barahuwa sub-station is the third largest sub-station of Gorakhpur District. The most important of any substation is the grounding (Earthing System) of the instruments, for the safety of the operating personnel as well as for proper system operation and performance of the protective devices. These ground the extra high voltage as it is dangerous to operate the instrument without proper earthing.

Moreover, the staff also the students that this substation has the capacity of 220kv and can step down to 132kv using four input lines through the incoming feeders.

The input feeders are namely,

PGCIL SAHJANWA, NTPC TANDA, GKP CKT-1, GKP CKT-2

The substation of 220kv/132kv has seven outgoing feeders, namely:

MAU-1, MAU-2(KAUDI RAM), FCI-1, FCI-2, ANAND NAGAR, GIDA

These out going feeders are of 132kv line. Further, the substation of 132kv/33ky has ten outgoing feeders, namely:

RUSTAMPUR, PGCIL SAHJANWA, LAL-DIGGI, NAUSAD, HARPUR GANGTAHI, STATION TRANSFORMER-1, STATION TRANSFORMER-2(COLONY), SAHJANWA, GIDA

16. Women Grievance Redressal Cell

Every citizen of the nation, male and female, enjoys in the right to education and work in a climate of wellbeing and security. The constitution of INDIA accommodates orientation “Gender Equality” and “Right to life and freedom” to all people under articles 14,19 and 21. It is hence obligation and command of each and every association to give upkeep of the central privileges to live and work with respect for all representatives: male and female. At the same time, people in some cases face infringement of their essential freedoms. Due to the historical reasons, working women, often face difficulties and challenges at the work place, thereby necessitating the need for protective measures that safeguard women’s rights and safety.

16.1 About the cell

Women’s Grievance Cell is meant to safeguard and promote the wellbeing of all women employees and students of KIPM college. It takes care of all complaints of the students inside the campus during college hours. It also takes care of any act of misconduct by a person in authority. The cell is responsible for looking into any complaints filed by students and staff of the college.

16.2 Vision

We envision a safe environment and protection against sexual harassment of women at KIPM and for redressal of complaints of sexual harassment and to ensure gender equality in KIPM.

16.3 Mission

1. To provide safe workplace.
2. To develop a policy against sexual harassment for women at KIPM.
3. To ensure the implementation of the policy in letter and spirit through proper reporting of the complaints and their follow-up procedures.
4. To uphold the commitment of the Institute to provide an environment free of gender based discrimination.
5. To promote a social and psychological environment to raise awareness on sexual harassment in its various forms.
6. To create a secure physical and social environment to deter any act of sexual harassment.

16.4 Objectives

- The Cell shall process all the individual complaints and take appropriate action.
- To organise awareness programmes on gender issues from time to time.
- To provide a platform for listening to any complaint put up by the students.
- Any redressal action would be taken up in consultation with the higher authority.
- The Cell may form/review the guidelines/policies for redressal of the grievance as required from time to time, which may be in accordance with those issues by government agencies.

16.5 Grievance Redressal Procedure

- Any women employee or female student will have the right to lodge a complaint concerning any kind of harassment.
- The Chairperson will transfer the complaint to the Women Grievance Cell.
- The coordinator will convene a meeting on the matter for further necessary action.
- The complaint will stand dropped if the committee after an enquiry is not able to prove prima-facie an offence of harassment.
- Any irrational complaint lodged shall be viewed seriously by the Cell. And, it shall have the right to decide upon the course of action thereafter.

16.6 Grievance Procedure

1. Any women employee or female student will have the right to lodge a complaint concerning sexual harassment against a male student or the employee of the institute by writing a letter or putting the complaint in the principal's office.
2. The complaint will be afforded full confidentiality at this stage.
3. After receiving the complaint, the chairman shall convene the meeting of the cell.
4. The chairman will appoint investigation committee, Coordinator will convene the meetings.
5. The investigation committee shall then decide the course of action to proceed.
6. The complaint will stand dropped if in accordance to the committee the complaint has not been able to disclose prima-facie an offence of sexual harassment by complainer /her representative.
7. In case the investigation committee decides to proceed with the complaint, the wishes of the complainer shall be ascertained and if the complainer wishes that a warning will suffice then alleged offender shall be called to the meeting of the committee, heard and if satisfied that a warning is just and proper, he will be warned about his behaviour and non-occurrence of it.
8. In case the complainer requests that the complaint should be proceeded with beyond mere a warning, the same may be proceeded with in the manner prescribed hereafter.

16.7 Procedure for investigation

1. If the complainer wishes to proceed beyond a mere a warning to the accused, the accused shall be given in writing by the investigation committee an opportunity to explain within one week why he should not be, for good and sufficient reasons, be punished for the act of sexual harassment on his part.
2. If the written explanation of the accused is not found to be satisfactory or if he does not provide any written explanation, the investigation committee will decide whether the offence deserves a minor penalty or a major penalty.
3. In the event that the investigation committee deciding that the accused be imposed a minor penalty, the said penalty will be recommended by the investigation committee to the chairman of the cell for decision.
4. If the investigation committee comes to a conclusion that the accused in case if his guilt proved, should be imposed a major penalty, it shall make a recommendation of action. If the accused is an employee, he may be placed under suspension under the provisions of act.

5. If a person is charged with physical molestation or rape on college / society's premises, he shall be immediately placed under suspension pending the completion of the investigation and enquiry. Appropriate actions can be initiated as per the laws of Indian penal code.

16.8 Punishment for sexual harassment

1. Any member of the institute fraternity (student/employee/outsider related to institute) found guilty of sexual harassment shall be liable to be punished. This shall be subject to the same penalties for major or minor misconduct as prescribed under government/ university rules.
2. A student guilty of sexual harassment shall be liable for any of the following penalties:
 - i. Warning or reprimand
 - ii. Suspension from university/ college for a period of one month
 - iii. Debarment from appearing for the examination for a period up to three years
 - iv. Rustication from the university as the case may be.
 - v. Any other punishment as defined by the government/ university act

16.9 Protection against Victimization:-

The committee noted and approved the policy on Protection against Victimization of the Women's Grievance Redressal Cell as following-

- (a) In the event of the complainant being a student and the accused being a teacher, during the pendency of the investigation and inquiry and even after such an enquiry if the teacher is found to be guilty, the accused will not act as an examiner for any examination for which the student appeals
- (b) In the event the complainant and the accused both being employees, during the pendency of the investigation and enquiry even after such an enquiry if the accused is found to be guilty, the accused shall not write the condition reports of the complainant, if it is otherwise so authorized.
